The purpose of the Tech Summit is to help people with an Intellectual or Developmental Disability, their families, professionals, allies, and advocates to learn how technology can help enhance people's independence and self-determination.

The purpose of the Tech Host Agency is to provide support to people with I/DD to be able to fully participate in the Summit.

What does being a Tech Host Agency mean?

As a Tech Host Agency, we want you to recruit and support at least five people with I/DD to attend the June 15, 2023 virtual Tech Summit. This might mean everyone is attending individually, using their own computer or as a group in a conference room on one computer with a projector. You would provide the support they might need such as registering, attending the optional pre-meeting, joining the event, using Zoom, etc.

What help do you receive?

We will provide an optional Zoom pre-meeting session a week before the Tech Summit to meet people, answer any questions, and make sure everyone is able to fully participate in the Summit using Zoom as the platform. The optional pre-meeting will be June 7, 2023 at 11am ET.

We will highlight your agency as a Tech Summit supporter on our Webpage and provide an acknowledgement during the Summit itself.
